A prayer written by those meeting together after the Sunday service to pray for our mission and Ministry to Clitheroe.

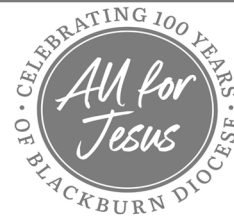
A prayer for healing:
